- c. Wiltshire Council – A reply from Development Control Wiltshire Council regarding drainage issues in Common Hill had been received. Following discussion it was felt that the matter could not be taken further by Cricklade Town Council and that it was a matter between the resident and Thames Water. The Assistant Town Clerk confirmed that the resident was aware. However, it was felt that the matter should be continued to be brought to the attention of planning officers in any further applications in the area.

09.165 Speed Limit Review - Report from Cllr Avenell had been circulated. Following discussion it was **RESOLVED** that we should respond as follows –

There should be one consistent speed limit (excluding those already in place through villages) on the B4040 from Cricklade to Malmesbury rather than the variable limits in place at the moment. However the proposals for the B4040 show Cricklade as having a 30mph limit and no 20mph limit, and at the end of the 30mph limit in Calcutt Street to the A419 Roundabout it is 60mph. This should be pointed out in our response.

The B4553 Purton to Cricklade road is to be reduced from 60mph to 50mph this was supported.

B4696 no change proposed and no comment.

09.166 High Street Car Park Update.

The Assistant Town Clerk reported that in line with recommendations from last meeting an

application for small community grant up to maximum of £5k has been submitted with the single quote obtained. Further quotes have been requested and are to be submitted by 19th Jan.

However, since the last meeting it appeared that other small community grant fund applications had been submitted and it is therefore recommended that we withdraw the application straightway as it would prevent further applications from other sources being made. This would enable us to concentrate on another award scheme (Performance Reward Grant Scheme) where applications still require support from Area Boards, which could possibly get us substantially more finance.

To enable us to do so we need a business plan and costing for the project. We therefore need to:-

Clarify whether any other parties are interested in this project and what input they could have in terms of management and know how.

In the light of this cost out the proposals, possibly using professional advice to draw up detailed plans and costing for implementation either on a stage basis or as a single project. Officers felt that we need to ensure that Project Management costs are part of any proposals as insufficient expertise or resource is available internally.

Following discussion it was **RESOLVED** that the recommendations were implemented and that a further report would be provided at the next meeting.

Our grounds men have done some limited work clearing trees that were overhanging the existing car park and discovered an 18" difference in levels. We have gone back to the provider of our original quotation who has confirmed he may need to relook at the estimate he provided.

Some concerns have been raised about the lighting of the area after dark – there is none at present.

A photo of the entrance to The Club has been passed to Wiltshire Council Conservation Officer to confirm that no planning application needed for the disabled ramp that we undertook to provide. We await confirmation.
